KANENGO stands for Kamuli Network of NGOs, a civil society organization in Kamuli district of Uganda. KANENGO operates throughout Kamuli district and is made up of Neighborhood Assemblies (NAs) or Community Parliaments. These NAs or community parliaments convene regularly to discuss and find solutions to common community problems. The NAs work in partnership with district and sub-county local governments. They also seek support from local and international NGOs and development partners.

Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) have in recent years emerged as a major issue of concern among NAs, and also nationally and around the world. This is because NCDs kill silently and often suddenly. Most people do not know they have NCDs. NCDs arise from unhealthy/risky lifestyles which can be changed. NCDs can be prevented. And NCDs now trend as a major national and global problem.

NCD1 /2015: Strengthening the capacity of communities to prevent, detect and treat NCDs in 5 sub-counties in Kamuli district, Uganda

NCD2 /2017: Promoting awareness, capacity, advocacy, and accountability for NCDs in 7 sub-counties in Kamuli district, Uganda

NCD3/ 2019: Strengthening the engagement between communities and duty bearers to improve NCD service delivery in Kamuli district

NCD4/2020: Empowering change agents to have the necessary capacity to reach citizens in Kamuli district with NCD, COVID-19 and other health messages and promote behavioral change on a sustainable basis.
